Assembly Instructions:

1. Print both pages. Printing on cardstock is recommended for durability.
2. Begin with page 2. Cut across the bottom horizontal line and discard the small strip.
3. Cut out and discard the half-oval at the left side of page 2.
4. Cut out and discard the tall rectangle on page 2.
5. Fold page 2 on the horizontal line across its middle. The blank back should be to the inside.
6. Join the top edges of page 2 (opposite the fold) using tape.
7. Also tape across the right edge (opposite the half-oval cut out). This completes the Transposer case.
8. Cut page 1 on the horizontal line across its middle.
9. Slide the top half of page 1 into the Transposer case. (The arrow should be visible in the space from the oval cutout on the Transposer case.)
10. Assembly is now complete. For any piece of music in the major keys, you can now slide the insert out to find its key in the tall rectangular window, then look to the right of each note to find its corresponding note in the key of C major.
